1. Target intervention project for high risk group community (female sex workers and also MSM) supported By the APSACS- Vijayawada, Andhra Pradesh:

Enhanced scope and ambit with the introduction of the present migrant strategy of including focus on source districts to Destinations the system could well be maintained as the Program for Cooperative Cataloguing in which the Potential HRG, returnee HRG, spouses of HRG mainly women and stakeholders are covered through Providing information, linkages to services for HRG and their partners at source, Strengthen linkages, Improving access to other social and development agencies and programmes to reduce vulnerability among targeted community, deep sea fisheries, stone quarries, brick kilns, Laborers Spread out across the City like Construction, Hotel Services, domestic work etc.

The High Risk Behavior ranging from consumption of drugs & alcohol high risk heterosexual and plural sexual relationships and lack of awareness, knowledge and safe sexual behaviors relating to STI/STD/RTI will make their reasons associated for the project operation. 2-4 times more number of HRG has non-regular partners or visit sex workers, and the prevalence consistently is more than one percent.

The outreach planning for the ORC for the current year worked out and the PE wise planning is being devised with the given parameters of enrolment registers, regular meeting and follow up of the HRG, identification of high risk and vulnerable zones, HRG master sheets with individual details and typology Etc. This apart the organization has pinned a large portion of the hope on the individualized involvement of the peers in accelerating the pace of the program. The peer education (PE) is routed through the VPL and multi-faceted component and its future plans are to extend the outreach so as to make the peer education to per grouping enabled.

SAMIDA has already been the implementing partner of targeted intervention all through the NACP III working with all the components of behavior change communication, enabling environment, condom promotion, STD treatment and extensive community mobilization in a bid to effectively organize the intervention. In this attempt the NGO has developed well established theatre for development, IEC material, IPC strategies and host area specific multi-pronged strategies along with Kalajatha.

The challenges are Coverage, Care and Support, Stigma and Discrimination, Enabling Environment and to counter all these proper strategies applied are scaling up and monitoring quality of Coverage, strengthening Enabling Environment, Enhancing access to services for Care, Support and Treatment, Strengthening the services under STI Management, Increased awareness and widespread communication strategies and bringing focus on Mainstreaming activities.





2. Skill Training of School Dropout Youth, Visakhapatnam, Andhra Pradesh with the support of the Functional Vocational Training and Research Society (FVTRS) Bangalore

The organization SAMIDA has been implementing the programs with participation of every stakeholder with whom we work with and expand his potential towards macro systems of nation and of development. ***This year we have been trained 150 drop out youth in different trades.*** Our main focus is down trodden youth like ST,SC and other vulnerable communities in the society.

Imbuing honesty and Integrity in all our initiatives with a stakeholder confidence and accountability to the ventures and productive returns, Gender Equity and equality at work place and promoting women empowerment rights and fostering equity and equanimity in their environment, Transparency & Accountability, Quality & Commitment in the areas of livelihoods enhancement, rights of children/women/destitute and orphans and designing the programs proportionate to the promotion of income generation and sustainable well-being.

The objective is organizing vulnerable communities into organized groups and institutions which would act as leveraging source of linkages and establish the Support & nurture to mobilize resources and enable them as sustainable entities. - Training cum demonstration Centre to impart technical inputs for improving the knowledge in service, processing, manufacturing for value addition in habitations and empowering through capacity building of youth in application of appropriate technology for sustainable management






Skill trainings have increased incomes by designing the effective marketing and making self-reliance a continuing mission. Strengthening the Dropout youth economically viable while simultaneously making the individual members more organized and promote the entrepreneurship. Primarily there is a noticeable stoppage of migration and induce them in the vocational occupations towards empowerment and in the urban front the youth have learnt the trades that will harness the skills for employment generation, livelihoods and productive utilization in the mechanical/auto/driving/computer fields

The Garment making, tailoring and embroidery has turned out to be the encouraging and promising course both for employment or self-employment and through this vocation training the linkages are established with Gramaikya Sangam of village Panchayaths and hence the easy accesses are established for procuring their needed equipment to each of the trainees who are self-employed and are self-employed. From among the trained some are worked out to be placed in Brandix establishment which houses employments to women.



Similarly in the Zari and Zardosi trade all the 30 trainees are self-employed with the assistance of Gramaikya Sangam, SHG bank linkage and have been a hand in glove in extending the revolving loans to the groups in procuring the needed frames, equipment and raw material. The credit linkages offered are to the extent of Rs 3000 to each member and 15000 for a group and the 6 groups with a loan of 90000 are doing well in earning the livelihoods.

In the Mobile servicing section for 8 trainees the shops are providing employment and 11 trainees have framed to operate their own servicing points and own repairing outlets. 5 trainees have applied for other linkages from corporations or banks and the rest 6 are still in the process of finding the avenue but on an average all are in an earning position. The mobile trades are favored basing on the evidenced demand for them to eke out instant and sustaining incomes and market susceptibility which are both from the demand and supply sides are feasible



Field level networking and entrepreneurship exercises are undertaken for inputs on marketing phases, Information about local dependent economy on these trades, local demand, job market availability and linkages etc. The linkages of banks and private financial institutions and availing

of Govt. schemes are identified and made a focus for accessing them and extend training opportunities for skill up-gradation. The NGO is continuously making references and contacts for forward and backward linkages from the credit institutions or charity linkages or government contacts etc.

With a commitment to impart social skills based employability trainings and towards institution building these have started at selected place with chosen topics through experienced resource persons and in this mission hereby the EDP is commenced at venue.

Creates a 'safe' environment, in which all staff members are treated equally and fairly, and in which they can perform to the best of their abilities. Understands and acting on the need of staff to be informed about issues that affect them personally and that affect the work unit. Conducts effective meetings and exhibits constructive communication outside the organizational unit. Communicate the reasoning for a decision. The SAMIDA has organized the PRA as a major thrust of the field movement to help to understanding the socio-economic status of the households, livelihoods, income and expenditure pattern, community dynamics, people's participation level, relationships with different institutions, trends of employment, social stigmas, resources, best practices, deviant behaviors of youth towards employability, workforce demand supply gap and women participation in employment sector and prominently to institute the skill training trades as per the wishes of the community during dates 02/01/2017 to 04/02/2017 in 6 grama pachayaths (24 villages) and the resource persons Mr. Kimmy Mthus and Ms. Debosri from FVTRS Bangalore have facilitated the program and the internal resource persons have taken part in this. The goal of the project SCOPE is to equip 1000 school dropout Tribal youth under SCOPE model with livelihood skills and to promote community owned and selected Multiple Vocational Resource trainings and skill development circles under SCOPE model for empowerment and sustenance for dropout youth, never enrolled, unorganized unskilled adolescents and for destitute adolescent girls

The exercise included different tools of

- Social mapping – this will help identify the social-cultural and economic status
- Resource mapping – this will help in capturing the resources and infrastructures available and how those can be sustainably utilized for employment and income generation
- Transect walk – this will reflect the present use of the resources and probable opportunities for development
- Inflow-outflow mapping – this will help address the inflow and outflow of the produces
- Human Development Index Analysis – this will help in analysing the trend of income, migration, shift of livelihood, development of life style etc.

- Venn diagram – this will help in understanding the relationship and access of the people to different infrastructures, institutions
- Trend analysis- this will help capture the historical trend of income and livelihood
- Seasonal calendar – NTFP / Agriculture / Horticulture / Animal / Fishery etc.
- Skill mapping - reflect the demand and supply of young workforce in employment market, types of employment, behavioral changes towards sectors and analysis of local employability
- To find out whether the CBOs are in the state of owning the skill building processes in future by them.
- Consultative discussions with the CBOs will give a clear picture of potentiality of community towards building a sustainable skill promotion model, identify key players and relational analysis. The consultation will include functional SHG, Vana Saranshkhya Samiti, Farmer's group and other user groups.
- Focus Group Discussion will be conducted in each village to understand the social dynamics, relationship, power structure, opportunities and constraints for skill promotion, livelihood structure, and resources available, decision making process and will help in selection of the skill development committee.
- The Focused group discussion are conducted with trainees trained by FVTRS and other training organizations, general population, Community level institutions, youth groups, Institutions offering skill training, Vocational training institutions, both Government and Private and Employment exchange.
- One GP level FGD is conducted to rationalize the findings from the village level FGDs and will select the Skill-development Committee members.





3. Community based Rapid HIV Testing Program - AIDS Healthcare Foundation –India Care

With the partnership of AIDS Healthcare Foundation (AHF), an international not for profit, nongovernmental organization (NGO) is the largest HIV/AIDS organization in the world, the SAMIDA has undertaken the Community Based Testing CBT in terms of community based rapid testing activity

As part of this project the SAMIDA has taken up the rapid testing program in view of the world AIDS day falling on Dec 1st during 1st December 2016 to 21st December 2016 period and recorded a staggering 1209 tests and zero positivity of 22 PLHIV cases identified and followed up the incident with the technical support of the AHF India Cares New Delhi. In this program we are identified the 22 PLHIVs in the target area and also we are linking with the ICTC & ART centers for their further follow up purpose, and followed by medical care with a mission of “providing cutting-edge medicine and advocacy, regardless of ability to pay. It provides direct support and technical assistance to establish sustainable and replicable models for the delivery of quality testing, linkages, referrals and follow up that leads towards comprehensive HIV/AIDS treatment, care and support services together with distribution of 43,200 male condoms.

Public awareness will be increased about HIV, especially among MSM, Transgender, Female sex Workers, youth, woman and other Vulnerable Population. This will include general awareness about HIV/AIDS, HIV testing services and availability of HIV treatment and care services (including ART).

- ❖ Implementation of Free HIV Testing Program at all testing sites and events
- ❖ Prepare the community for HIV testing with outreach activities that mobilize enhanced attendance at testing sites and events.
- ❖ Conduct onsite pre-test counseling, free Rapid HIV testing and referral services following the standard protocols as provided by INDIA CARES.
- ❖ All clients who test positive by the first test have to be confirmed using a second test from a different company if available.
- ❖ All positive clients have to be connected to ICTC/ART services with name of AHF (AHF Name should be reflect in ICTC/ART record as a in referral unit).
- ❖ All identified new PLHIV Follow up will be done till the start of ART.
- ❖ All identified and ART linked new PLHIV will be follow up at least 2 time, after start of ART treatment.
- ❖ Link any other PLHIVs who might come in contact through other sources in its operational area to for necessary treatment, care and support services. In case that AHF India Cares Centre is not present in the operational city, the PLHIV will be linked to the Government ART Centre for treatment, care and support.

- ❖ Disseminate information to the target population on general health, hygiene, behavior change communication for prevention, HIV/AIDS services and distribute LOVE Condoms.

4. Partnership with Care & Share Italia Onlus ONG

SAMIDA has been the technical support partner to the Care & Share of Italy origin to nurture the sponsorship, vocational training and counseling to the 5000 children of underprivileged and vulnerable at Vijayawada and proposes to run student sponsorship programme to promote education among the children of low income families. This programme targets both boys and girls irrespective of caste and creed. The eligibility criteria include children having interest in studies, belonging to low income family, being an orphan or with a single parent, being a member of a large family.

The basic goal of the student sponsorship programme is to support a child and the family to come out of the vicious circle of poverty and have a promising future. The program aims at overall development of the students.

The students under this sponsorship programme are spread out in the whole districts of Krishna and Guntur. The children live with their families and we provide them assistance for their education. We will also admit children in boarding homes and colleges where there is no possibility for them to remain at home and continue their studies.

The program aims to give special importance to girl child education since girl gets educated converts her whole life and the life of her future family change towards good forever and girl child education has tremendous impact on the family welfare and society as a whole. The project will be implemented in collaboration with C & S Italia Foundation

II. Community contribution and philanthropy based initiatives through donations and charities

5. Awareness programs on safe drinking water, Sanitation and personal hygiene activities

The initiative will center on orienting the communities on safe drinking water, Sanitation and personal hygiene activities and awareness generation on the above subjects through the IEC campaigns, wall writings, brochures etc and developing the communication strategy as well as material, and launch a community based awareness campaign and capacity building on WASH activities. The TFD (Theater for development) – Kalajatha's on the safe drinking water practices, sanitation and hygiene, amplifying the ill effects of the ailing sanitation and hygiene, vows of bad water consumption practices, real tales that have happened on account of the bad water practices, and process to be adopted for the safe foundations of WASH practices are some of the characteristic features to be made out through this TFD avenue. IEC and its derivatives like posters, pamphlets, handouts, brochures etc along with puppet shows and peer motivation sessions applying the pictorial forms and handouts are to be employed. Essential strategy is making the

communities understand the systems on account of the bad WASH practices through different make shift communication forms by informed and designed teams.

6. Environmental Awareness

The initiatives are carried with the support of local resource groups of environment which is the continuous activity and such trainings in all the villages which training has equipped members in their respective occupations. The outcome of the training has been placing 300 members in environment. The trainings are organized with resource persons of environment drawn from field depending on the need and trainees vision. Initially the group exercises are organized to get to know of the potential to learn and get to know of each other and subsequently groups are formed for enabling them to make group exercises. The meagrely placed environment volunteers have partaken in the venture making it a mission for the NGO to have it continued for some other batches

We monitor long-term changes in the health of the area so as to record the changes effected by restoration measures, as also to improve the efficiency and effectiveness of our interventions. In this mission we partner with a large and robust constituency of village communities and with academia, local elected representatives and government functionaries to promote concerted action for promoting environment promotion and do away with the un-sanitation and De-WASH drives. Our experiences on the ground give us valuable insights into the working of the community mind, the views on environment development, and their perception of public policy on community wellbeing.

The objective is organizing vulnerable communities into organized groups and institutions which would act as leveraging source of linkages for Environmental Awareness and establish the Support & nurture to mobilize resources and enable them as sustainable entities.

Enable the communities to devise the linkages and accesses during distress and during the times of calamities and negotiate with different agencies for strengthening the community efforts, to enhance quality of life of the people by increasing the awareness on environmental awareness and to make 100% sanitation in the respective villages to increase more awareness on environmental issues and reduce the pollution are the visions. Promotion of community climate change projects namely tree saplings, forest protection, school environment, sanitation, personal health and hygiene, cure, support services of forest logging etc.

7. Other general awareness activities with the support of the local donations like Awareness on RTI, RTE, DV act, MGNREGS act, Water and sanitation

These voluminous migrations are adding misery to the existing issues of shortage of water, unhealthy competition for the wage earnings, queuing up of the migrant labor at source points apart from several of the social issues. This apart the health, hygiene, sanitation are the added vows to the sprawling vicinities, transport imbroglio and the recent HudHud mega cyclone has totally

eradicated the dwelling components in the areas. The micro analysis of the situation has been a repellent to the existing Govt. programs and are negating the linkage networks and accessing of the schemes. The present requisites include Community mobilization, Infrastructure creation/repair, Command area development, livelihoods and agricultural support in terms of providing the livelihoods and household food security and providing the market linkages.

Serve communities to address local problems which have national replicable benefits as per 10th Plan need for water harvesting, conservation of all life forms and sustainable utilization of resources while seeking to enhance sustainable livelihood systems considering deteriorating conditions of fragile ecosystems, deforestation, loss of biodiversity and pollution etc on the necessity of protecting the long-term ecological security. A perspective 'from below', of low-income households and marginalized communities and migrants to strengthen their self-help and self-reliance capacities through innovative and catalytic, 'action-research' type of intervention by bringing a diverse set of development partners and to devise innovative solutions to development challenges of livelihoods that will address multi-sector dimensions of development programming and integrating programming at Visakhapatnam District and the city. Added is the comprehensive monitoring and documentation of development innovations to raise policy issues related to the rights of marginalized communities and cross-cutting issues such as equity and people's empowerment, gender sensitivity, integration of biodiversity into all sectors of planning, integration of indigenous knowledge systems, and national issues.

It envisages strong linkages with past and ongoing processes as part of the strategy for creating synergy and dissemination of technologies, transferability and scalability of innovative approaches. Establishing a self-sustaining, evergreen financial resource using decentralized, demand-driven and participatory mechanisms to improve project effectiveness, ensuring local relevance, building an "action-oriented livelihoods centre of excellence" towards establishing systems for enhancing the livelihoods options through action based pilot projects, which have local livelihood benefits are the aspects.

The systems will establish broad based, flexible, sound and transparent assessments, which promote and enhance capacities, build private-public partnerships, policies and practices like local resource mobilization, links to governments & replication and scaling up of sound and benefiting community livelihoods projects. This vision would enable the "Successful implementation of livelihoods promotion to migrants" that would have achieved measurable, quantifiable and qualitative results while adhering to high-quality and fair practices and processes.

Pro-active demand from the communities, institutions for scaling-up and it should not as a top-down initiative rather that meets the local demands, links markets, and sustains actions on scale and areas, reflect in the share of community contribution out of the total co-financing are the broad rationale of this concept promulgation.
