## **74<sup>th</sup> Republic Day Celebrations at Asha Kiran Schools of Rotary India Literacy Mission on 26<sup>th</sup> Jan 2023**

The Asha Kiran schools of Rotary India Literacy Mission at Ananthagiri Mndal of Alluri Seetha Rama Raju District Andhra Pradesh under the aegis of SAMIDA have organized the 74<sup>th</sup> Republic day celebrations in their respective schools with a common slogan of Azadi Ka Amruth Mahotsav.

Prior to the celebration, the day before, the schools have been very well decorated with the locally available flowers and leafs, cleansing of the campuses, rally to make other children partake in the celebrations and all the other community members.

On the specific day the tricolors have been unfurled and the national anthem is harmonically bashed at and the sweets are distributed and congratulated each other on being part of this occasion.

The Chief Guests of the concern Government school teachers has given a brief of the Republic Day saying that while India has its Independence Day on August 15 when it earned freedom from the British Rule, Republic Day commemorates the constitution coming into force. January 26 was the chosen date since it was on this day in 1929 that the Indian National Congress issued the Declaration of Indian Independence (Purna Swaraj). The constitution came into effect two days later, on January 26, 1950, which completed India's transition to a sovereign republic. He mentioned that the independence has been a much important occasion for the younger generations to understand the importance of its significance and asserted that independence has been a gift to Tribal Children.

Another speaker our Asha Kiran center valunteers maintained that Tribal communities pan India, have played a key role in conserving the rich culture and heritage of our country. Their contributions to freedom struggle have been highlighted through various initiatives under the aegis of Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav. The significant role of the tribal community in evolving narrative of India is well established, be it their contribution to the freedom struggle, field of sports or business.

The President SAMIDA has said that the Tribal Identity, Tribal Education, Tribal Entrepreneurship are few names that have given us a to the explosive talent of tribal education enrichment, up gradation, sports, centre of Excellence are being through the independence that are linked to rural and tribal population.
