

SAMIDA was functioning for Rolugunta Mandal as its base. SAMIDA has taken of many activities such as Education, Health, water & sanitation, SME (Small & Medium Enterprise Development program, Panchayatiraj activities on Grama Swaraj concept, Environmental protection and Development & Forest Management program through Vana Samrakshana Samithi (VSS), Micro Finance (Thrift & Credit Program for women) & Sramadan activities etc. The organization was developed good rapport with other Non Governmental Organizations (NGOs) & government Organizations in Visakhapatnam Dt. We established a good rapport and good

relationship with the community. The organization was developed a good rapport with other funding agencies & Government Officials.

The President, Secretary, Treasurer and other executive body of the organization are personally trained social workers. By doing field work at academic level as well as in the organizations on various projects they obtained huge experience in NGO sector. The society has good office building and other infrastructure. We collect a data for disability in our community area. We are approach other agencies also for support and sustain our organization.

ACTIVITIES OF THE YEAR 2009-2010

Fund Mobilization

- The organization was mobilized fund of Rs. 2,50,096/- for Residential Bridge course center running purpose through the Rajeev Vidhya Mission Govt of Andhra Pradesh.
- The organization was mobilized Loan from Rs 14,00,000/- for Income Generation Programme for the rural poor. In this year we received Rs 5,00,000/- only from Rashtriya Grameen Vikas Nidhi, Bhuvaneswar.
- The organization was mobilized fund of Rs.1,51,600/- loan linked savings from the loan taken members. The amount is also given the loans for IGP activities during the year 2009-2010.
- The organization was mobilized fund of Rs.1, 67,187/- Donations from public & members of the organization for organization ongoing activities and community Development Activities purpose during the year 2009-2010.
- The organization was Mobilized funds Rs 28,500/- for Environmental awareness Champaign purpose from the Minister of Environment -Forest Govt of India & the organization members.
- The organization was received funds Rs 1, 55,529/-from SUPPORT Nellore for those who are living with HIV/AIDS for their care & support and Nutrition support Activities and awareness Champaign purpose.

Education

- The organization was conducted a survey on child labor and school dropouts children in Rolugunta and Ravikamatham Mandals.
- The organization was running Residential Bridge course center running e through the Rajeev Vidhya Mission/SSA Govt of Andhra Pradesh in Rolugunta Village, Rolugunta Mandal with the support of the Rajeev Vidhya Mission/SSA Govt of Andhra Pradesh. Under this program we are covered 60 children. Exclusively school Dropout children in Rolugunta, Ravikamatham, Narsipatnam mandas in Visakhapatnam District. In this programme we are already mainstreamed 360 children's in deferent schools and hostels in Visakhapatnam Dt.
